Examination

One: The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with you.

Many: **The Lord bless you.**

One: Prepare our hearts and minds, Lord, to accept your word. Silence in us any voice but your own, that hearing, we may also obey your will through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Many: **Amen**

Scripture

1st Corinthians 11:23-26

For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night that he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, “This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me. In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this as, often as you drink it, in remembrance of me. For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord’s death until he comes.

Affirmation

One: We shall affirm our faith in God's love for the world and its people:

Many: **God so loved the world that he gave his only son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. God sent his son into the world not to condemn the world, but that the world through him might be saved. This is our faith. Lord, help our faith to grow.**

Communion

One: This is the Lord's Table. Our Savior invites those who trust him to share the feast he has prepared.

One: The Lord be with you.

Many: **And also with you.**

One: Lift up your hearts.

Many: **We lift them to the Lord.**

One: It is our delight, God of the universe, to give you thanks through Jesus Christ. You said, 'Let there be light', and the light came, to shine on in our darkness. For you the earth has brought forth life in all its forms. You have created us to hear your word, to do your will, and to be filled in your love.

Many: **It is right to thank you. You sent your son to be for us the way we need to follow and the truth we need to know.**

One: Your Son came to give us life and to set us free from sin. His cross takes our guilt away. You send your Holy Spirit to strengthen and to guide, to warn and to revive your Church. Therefore, with all who love you, who surround us on every side, countless as heaven's stars, we praise you for our creation and our calling, with loving and joyful hearts.

Many: **Holy God, holy and merciful, holy and just, glory and goodness come from you. Glory to you, most high and gracious God.**

One: God of the past and the present, with this bread and wine we remember your son.

Many: **We thank you for his life, his death and resurrection. We look for his coming in glory and in him we give ourselves to you.**

One: God of love, send your Holy Spirit upon these gifts, that as we receive this bread and wine we shall by faith receive the body and blood of Christ.

Many: **Called to follow him, help us to reconcile and unite. Called to serve, give us hope in our calling.**

Receiving Communion

Words of Institution (in unison)

The Bread which we break is the communion of the body of Christ.

Words of Institution (in unison)

The Cup which we bless is the communion of the blood of Christ.

The Lord's Prayer (in unison)

(New English Version - adopted by the Church of England in 1977)

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name. Your Kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours. Now and forever. Amen.

One: Lord Jesus Christ, we thank you with all our heart for your mercy and grace. Give us now and in the days to come a living hope in you; and as we serve you in the world, help us look and work for that day when at your name every knee shall bow, and every tongue confess you Lord to the glory of God the Father. Amen.
