The Jacob L. Adams Elementary School Gator Family is inviting you to be a part of our school community. We were fortunate to have Pastor Dave and Susan Robertson join us during the month of May to assist with classroom activities and one to one student assistance. The administration, teachers, and students were most grateful for the invaluable experience.

WHAT'S NEEDED

In-person volunteers for: Classroom Assistance (grades K-5); Reading with students (morning hours); Assistance with teacher led activities; Lunch Buddy

VOLUNTEER DAYS/TIMES: Monday-Friday — 8:00 A.M.-1:00 PM

* The hopes are the day/time would be consistent to allow for teacher planning and preparation. 60-minute weekly visits are suggested, but visits may be more frequent/extended as you are willing/able. Anytime you can spare and share is appreciated! It is important to know that Henrico Public Schools requires all volunteers to complete a volunteer application (https://henricoschools.us/volunteers/). Once the application is complete, the prospective volunteer will receive an email of receipt, and another once approved. From there, visits will be based on the schedule we develop per volunteer availability.

CAN'T PARTICIPATE IN-PERSON: If you are not able to provide in-person support, no worries. Jacob L. Adams has opportunities to assist in other ways — Donations of gently used clothing for our clinic and families in crisis; Gift card donations for student attendance incentives (attendance is linked to school accreditation). Places in close proximity and frequently visited by our students - Chick-fil-A, McDonald's, Marco's Pizza, Five Below, Walmart, Target.
