ver the past year or two, our adult Sunday school class has studied books, been taught by Rev. Freda with curriculum from the Baptist Women's Missionary Union of Virginia, and have used the Brethren's Guide for Biblical Studies. We will have completed our last book, The World, The Flesh, and the Devil by Richard Rohr. As a class, in November, we want to explore using the TV series, The Chosen as possible Sunday School curriculum later on.

tarting the first Sunday of December, we will pick up the Guide for Biblical Studies based on the International Sunday School Lessons Uniform Series (ISSI). The series we use is written from a Church of the Brethren perspective and contains daily NRSV scriptures, lessons, and questions for both individual preparation and small group use.

he ISSI is a 6-year plan for reading and studying the entire Bible. It is designed

to take students into every part of Scripture, the Uniform Series pulls at least one lesson from nearly every book of the Bible over the 6-year cycle, following 8 specific themes.

The four themes of the 2023–2024 study are:

- God's Law Is Love—Luke, John, Acts, Romans, 1 Corinthians, Galatians, Colossians
- Faith That Pleases God—Ruth, 1 Samuel, 2 Chronicles, Proverbs, Isaiah, Daniel, Habakkuk, Matthew, Luke, Romans, Hebrews
- **Examining Our Faith**—Matthew, Mark, Luke, Acts, Romans, 2 Corinthians, 1 Peter, Jude
- Hope in the Lord—Acts, Romans, 2 Corinthians, Colossians, Hebrews, 1 Thessalonians, Titus, 1 John

e will begin with the Winter Quarter, Faith That Pleases God. You can see the different books of the Bible that we will be reading in this quarter. It is a wide range of books covering both the Old and New Testament sections of the Bible. Student books are ordered and will be handed out when we receive them. Let me know if you want me to hold a book for you.

> ou do not have to be a scholar of the Bible to join Sunday school. You do, however, need to have a thirst for truth. The only requirement needed for the class is a personal Bible. We do have extra Bibles here at church if you wish to use one.







#### Let's Revive Sunday Fellowship Time!
