Scripture Lesson

¹⁴ When the time came, Jesus took his place at the table, and the apostles joined him. ¹⁵ He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer. ¹⁶ I tell you, I won't eat it until it is fulfilled in God's kingdom." ¹⁷ After taking a cup and giving thanks, he said, "Take this and share it among yourselves. ¹⁸ I tell you that from now on I won't drink from the fruit of the vine until God's kingdom has come." ¹⁹ After taking the bread and giving thanks, he broke it and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body, which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me." ²⁰ In the same way, he took the cup after the meal and said, "This cup is the new covenant by my blood, which is poured out for you.

Sermon "Remember/Re-member"

Response of Remembrance

Pastor: Remember, O Lord, Your great mercy and love, for they

are from of old. (Psalm 25:6)

People: Remember not the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways; according to your love remember me, for you

are good, O Lord. (Psalm 25:7)

Pastor: "The time is coming," declares the Lord, "when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel... For I will forgive

their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.

(Jerimiah 31:31,34)

People: The Lord is gracious and compassionate. He

remembers his covenant forever. (Psalm 111:4-5)

Pastor: Remember the gracious love of our Lord in heaven

People: who made us children of his own possession.

Pastor: Remember Jesus Christ, sent by God to share our human nature, to live and to die as one of us, and so to move us from the alienation of sin and death.

People: to reconcile us to God by his perfect sacrifice, and through his suffering, death, and resurrection to save all who put their trust in him.

Pastor: Remember the Holy Spirit, who teaches us these things

People: and makes the effects of Christ's salvation real in our lives.
