There are times in the Bible When God sets up these really lopsided contests To prove without a shadow of doubt That the LORD God Is the one and only true God.

When Gideon mustered an army of 32,000 God told Gideon he had too many soldiers.

If they'd win the battle They'd believe it was by their own doing.

So God chiseled Gideon's army Down from 32,000 to 300 To face a force of 135,000 Midianites.

Gideon defeated them without the use of any weapons.

Today's lesson is another example Where God uses a lopsided contest To prove the same point

There is no other God than YHWH.

~~

It's been 100 years since Kind David Ruled a powerful and united Israel.

That once great nation now divided By the blunders of King Solomon's son, Rehoboam.

King Ahab is now the king of Israel.

Ahab's wife is the notorious Queen Jezebel.

Jezebel perverted and corrupted Ahab Which really was none too difficult a task.

He was pretty much a rascal from the start.

She led him away from the LORD God To worship both Baal the god of rain And Asherah, the goddess of fertility.

Jezebel had killed most of God's prophets Leaving Elijah as one of the few remaining prophets

Elijah was quite the bur in Jezebel's saddle.

She hated him and those feelings were mutual.

In chapter 17

God informed Elijah to inform Ahab A drought was coming.

An in-your-face challenge to the god, Baal, the god of rain ~~

What followed was what Shontell read for us today.

You see, the situation had become like this.

That not only had Ahab Combined both the faiths in God and in Baal

But that Ahab and Jezebel pushed all of Israel To leave or at least dilute their faith in God And adopt the faith in the god of Baal And the goddess of Asherah. But remember the LORD God does not have any patience When it comes to worshiping others gods.

1

Exodus 34:14 "for you shall worship no other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God"

And so, Elijah asks the people of Israel

"How long? Really, how long will you keep going Limping between two opinions?"

"If God is God, follow Him. But if Baal, follow him."

In other words, there is no neutral zone.

It's one way or another You can't have it both ways You can't try to please all the gods.

There is only one God you need to please.

You cannot live between God and things that replace god.

You MUST choose.

The LORD God demands total devotion.

# Joshua 24:15 CEB

<sup>15</sup> But if it seems wrong in your opinion to serve the Lord, then choose today whom you will serve.

We live in a time similar to this time in Israel's history.

We, too, are bombarded by multiple gods Each vying for our devotion. Like King Ahab and Queen Jezebel We live in a society that is a pluralistic society.

There are all kinds of gods vying for our devotion.

In order for the people to consider other gods. Faith in the LORD God has to be challenged

When a drought occurred back then in Israel's history Ahab used the occasion to present Baal, the rain god.

Baal the rain god will bring rain. Your god doesn't seem to answer prayers for rain.

We currently live in a society with multiple gods.

The thinking goes, all our needs can be met By going to the different gods.

That I can take what I want from this god And take from this other god And blend it to make it my own faith

What are the false gods we seek and cling to

Our work, our careers, our hobbies, our bodies

We live for the gods of vacation and weekends The god of fine dining, and expensive clothing

We worship the god of our material possessions The god of our investments and retirement.

Anytime we worship things and not God They end up taking the place of God. And many things can become really addictive.

Things like drugs, alcohol, pornography, sex All start out as things we worshiped.

They are false gods.

These are gods that take control of our lives That have the ability to possess us spiritually That damage our relationship with God.

~~

Take for instance the idea of the perfect body.

Everywhere, we are bombarded by images of perfect bodies.

Men and women pumping iron etc.

Now, not everyone can achieve this kind of body. But we are led to believe we can.

The perfect shaped body becomes a false god And lures us into thinking We need to be like that!

This false god then takes control of our lives.

We become possessed.

We spend hours in front of the mirror Hours at the fitness centers. Hours fretting over a pound or two.

And this worship to a false god Ends up destroying us with bulimia or anorexia Or self-centered narcissism. It becomes God's spiritual competitors.

And robs us of God's life-giving Spirit.

~~

Elijah comes along and says, "No! that ain't going to work."

If God is God, follow Him.

If Baal, then follow him.

Don't just limp along divided between devotion to God And devotion to your false gods.

Call on the name of your false gods And see what they'll do.

Let's just see.

### 3

1 Kings 18:24 CEV

<sup>24</sup> Then all of you will call on the name of your god, and I will call on the name of the Lord. The god who answers with fire—that's the real God!"

The God who answers with fire.

The prophets of Baal worshiped Baal from morning til night.

Nothing happened

They performed for their god.

They danced around their sacrifice They cried, they moaned They cut themselves The DID what they thought would please their god.

Nothing happened.

Elijah prepared his sacrifice.

And Elijah prayed to the LORD God The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob

1 Kings 18:37 CEB

<sup>37</sup> Answer me, Lord! Answer me so that this people will know that you, Lord, are the real God and that you can change their hearts."

And God answered with fire.

Ohhhhh my God answered with fire.

God sent a lightning bolt down on that sacrifice.

It struck that soggy hunk of meat That soaked firewood All that standing water

And consumed everything.

Nothing was left.

When John was baptizing people for the repentance of sins He said

He came to divide the people between Those who worship the false gods With the ones who worship the one true God.

Why?

So that we may know the God that changes hearts.

It was 50 days after Jesus rose from the dead.

People waited in prayer

And the Lord answered with fire from above.

To bring division.

Choose this day whom you will serve.

Then stop limping between two opinions.

Drop the false gods you currently worship.

They make you dance They will make you cry They will make you hurt yourself. But not the true God.

The true God will fill you with the Holy Spirit.

He will change your heart. And transform your life.

Pray like Elijah.

I close with a prayer from CH Spurgeon.

Pray with me With your palms turned up towards heaven.

O God, send us the Holy Spirit.

Give us both the breath of spiritual life And the fire of unconquerable zeal

Till nation after nation Shall yield to the sway of Jesus.

O Thou who are our God Answer us by fire, we pray Thee.

Answer us both by wind and fire And then we shall see Thee To be God indeed.

The kingdom comes not And the work is flagging.

Oh that Thou wouldst send the wind and the fire!

Thou will do this when we are all of one accord. All believing All expecting All prepared by prayer.

Lord bring us to this waiting state.

God, send us a season of glorious disorder.

Oh for a sweep of the wind that will set the seas in motion And make our ironclad brethren Now lying so quiet at anchor To roll from stem to stern!

Of for a fire to fall again Fire which shall affect the most stolid!

Of that such fire Might sit first upon the disciples And then fall on all around.

O Spirit of God!

Thou are ready to work with us today Even as Thou didst then.

Stay not, we beseech Thee But work at once.

Break down every barrier That hinders the incoming of Thy might!

Overturn!, overturn, O Sacred Wind! Consume all obstacles, O heavenly Fire! Give us now both the hearts of flame and tongues of fire To preach Thy reconciling Word for Jesus' sake!
